

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF BOND RESOLUTION SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE  
REFERENDUM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town Board of the Town of Parma, Monroe County, New York, at a meeting duly held on June 9, 2026, adopted a bond resolution authorizing the issuance of obligations of the Town for the purpose described therein.

This bond resolution is adopted subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Town Law of the State of New York. The bond resolution shall not take effect until thirty (30) days after its adoption, nor until approved by the qualified electors of the Town if, within such thirty-day period, a petition requesting a referendum thereon, subscribed and authenticated as required by law, is duly filed with the Town Clerk.

**NOTICE PURSUANT TO LOCAL FINANCE LAW SECTION 81.00**

The bond resolution published herewith was adopted on June 9, 2026, and the validity of the obligations authorized by such bond resolution may be hereafter contested only if such obligations were authorized for an object or purpose for which the Town of Parma is not authorized to expend money or if the provisions of law which should have been complied with as of the date of publication of this notice were not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within thirty (30) days after the date of publication of this notice, or such obligations were authorized in violation of the provisions of the constitution.

**RESOLUTION AND ORDER AFTER PUBLIC HEARING AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO  
THE OFFICE OF THE STATE COMPTROLLER REGARDING PROPOSED INCREASE IN THE  
MAXIMUM AMOUNT AUTHORIZED TO BE EXPENDED FOR THE TOWN OF PARMA  
WATER IMPROVEMENT BENEFIT AREA NO. 1**

At a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Parma, Monroe County, New York, held at the Parma Town Hall, 1300 Hilton Parma Corners Road, Hilton, New York, on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2026.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Parma previously established the Town of Parma Water Improvement Benefit Area No. 1 (“Water District”) pursuant to Article 12 of the New York Town Law and authorized improvements in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Town solicited and received bids for the installation and construction of the improvements for said Water District; and

WHEREAS, the bids received for the installation of said improvements were substantially higher than originally anticipated due to increased construction, labor, material, and related project costs; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board determined that it was necessary to consider an increase in the maximum amount authorized to be expended for said improvements; and

WHEREAS, the revised estimated maximum cost of said improvements is \$3,756,955.00 (\$1,308.07 per EDU), representing an increase of \$354,955.00 (\$210.54 per EDU) from the previously authorized amount of \$3,402,000.00 (\$1,097.52 per EDU); and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements consist generally of the construction, installation, replacement, and improvement of water mains, hydrants, service connections, appurtenances, and related water system facilities, together with all ancillary and incidental improvements in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the existing Town of Parma Water Improvement Benefit Area No. 1 shall remain unchanged; and

WHEREAS, the proposed method of financing consists of the issuance of bond anticipation notes, grants, and/or such other lawful funding sources as may be available; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of said improvements exceeds the NYS Comptroller's cost threshold, requiring approval of the Office of the State Comptroller pursuant to Article 12 of the New York Town Law; and

WHEREAS, the Town Engineer prepared updated maps, plans, reports, and cost estimates relating to said improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board duly adopted a Resolution and Order calling for a public hearing on the proposed increase in the maximum amount authorized to be expended for said improvements; and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was duly published and posted as required by law; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was duly held before the Town Board at the Parma Town Hall on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2026, at 6:30 p.m., at which time all persons desiring to be heard were duly heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DETERMINED, pursuant to Article 12 of the New York Town Law, as follows:

1. The Town Board hereby determines that it is in the public interest to increase the maximum amount authorized to be expended for improvements to the Town of Parma Water Improvement Benefit Area No. 1 from \$3,402,000.00 to \$3,756,955.00.

2. The Town Board further determines that the properties within said Water Improvement Benefit Area are benefited by said improvements.
3. The Town Board hereby authorizes and directs the Town Supervisor, Town Clerk, Town Attorney, Town Engineer, and Bond Counsel to prepare and submit an application to the Office of the State Comptroller seeking approval of the proposed increase in the maximum amount authorized to be expended for said improvements pursuant to the applicable provisions of the New York Town Law and the regulations of the Office of the State Comptroller.
4. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to forward certified copies of this Resolution, together with all required maps, plans, reports, estimates, affidavits, proofs of publication, and other supporting documentation, to the Office of the State Comptroller.
5. This Resolution is subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to the applicable provisions of the New York Town Law, and the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish and post notice of adoption of this Resolution in the manner prescribed by law.
6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately for purposes of publication and compliance with the permissive referendum procedures of the New York Town Law.
